TERMS OF REFERENCE

Title: Wildlex Intern

Duty Station: Environmental Law Centre, Bonn, Germany

Background

The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), established in 1948, is the oldest and largest global environmental organization in the world. Its work focuses on valuing and conserving nature, ensuring effective and equitable governance of its use, and deploying nature-based solutions to global challenges in climate, food and development. IUCN supports research, manages field projects all over the world, and brings governments, NGOs, the UN and companies together to develop policy, laws and best practices.

The IUCN Environmental Law Centre (ELC), located in Bonn, Germany, is an out posted unit of IUCN headquarters working on conceptual development of law as well as technical assistance, capacity building and information dissemination. It works closely with the World Commission on Environmental Law, a network of environmental law and policy experts from all regions of the world who volunteer their knowledge and services to IUCN activities, and with the IUCN Academy of Environmental Law, a network of universities and law schools committed to advancing environmental legal research, teaching and scholarship.

Description

The Wildlex Intern will support and assist in collecting, reviewing and analyzing cases for a repository of wildlife-related law with a strong focus on China.

The WILDLEX Intern will be responsible for:

- Selecting, collecting, reviewing, briefing and uploading legal cases to WILDLEX;
- Consolidating case information into database for quantitative analysis;
- Conducting analysis to determine characteristics and trends of cases;
- Developing charts and figures illustrating preliminary findings;
- Writing up a report of preliminary findings; and
- Manage and keep updated WILDLEX website.

Position requirements

The following qualifications are required:

- Currently pursuing graduate qualification in law, such as JD or Master's Degree;
- Strong writing and communication skills in English and Mandarin; and
- Proficiency with Excel and Microsoft Word.

Application restrictions in compliance with the German labor law and immigration requirements

- Candidates must be Chinese citizen
- Candidates must be in Germany on a valid visitor /student visa until 30.04.2020 (min.)
- Candidates must be studying at a German University
- Internship must be mandatory by the University study program
- Internship duration : 3 to 6 months in 2020
